Coffee Descriptions:

Cream City Blend (Regular and Decaf)

Named for the city in which it was created, our Cream City Blend is still hand-roasted in the Stone Creek Factory in downtown Milwaukee. This coffee is a friendly get together of our highest-quality Guatemalan, an extremely smooth and chocolaty Ethiopian Harrar, and our French Roast. Cream City Blend is a rich, full, mellow coffee that's as easy-going as the city for which it is named.

Organic Fair Trade Blend

The Sumatran coffee in this blend is organically grown coffee at family farms and blended with organically produced coffee from Peru to create a smooth well-balanced cup of coffee with a bright, fruity finish. Both coffees in this blend are Certified Fair Trade, meaning that each dollar we spend goes to provide the individual farmers with an equitable living wage.

French Roast

To create our French Roast, we have taken great care to craft a coffee that equals the legendary quality of the great French Roasts of Europe while preserving a flavor and distinction that is uniquely American. Our French Roast is a rich, dark cup of coffee with a noticeable undercurrent of bittersweet cocoa and a surprisingly smooth, satiny finish.

Hazelnut

This smooth, well-balanced coffee has the perfect touch of hazelnuts, just enough to let you know they're there but not enough to overpower the carefully roasted beans. With each sip you'll be tantalized by the rich taste and aroma of hazelnuts fresh from the shell.
