## **Requirements for Instrumental Lessons**

**Piano - Beginning in 2<sup>nd</sup> grade.** Students must have a piano or keyboard at home on which to practice. Keyboards are not available for rent from MPS.

Violin/Viola - Beginning in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade. Students must have an instrument on which to practice. A limited number of rental instruments are available through MPS.

Cello/Bass - Beginning in 4<sup>th</sup> grade. Students must have an instrument on which to practice. A limited number of rental instruments are available through MPS.

**Woodwind and Brass - Beginning in 4<sup>th</sup> grade.** Students must have an instrument on which to practice. A limited number of rental instruments are available through MPS.

**Percussion - Beginning in 4<sup>th</sup> grade.** Students must own a pair of drumsticks that are to be kept at home for practice. Hartford has drumsticks for students to use during their lessons.

## **Expectations for Instrumental Lessons**

- Instrumental students must have access to an instrument for weekly practice at home.
- Instrumental students must own a book for weekly practice at home.
- Instrumental students must attend their lessons weekly.
- Instrumental students must keep up with all regular class work missed due to lessons.
- Instrumental students must be respectful of their instructors.
- Instrumental students must be responsible for taking proper care of their instruments.

If it is the judgment of a child's classroom teacher that pull-out for instrumental lessons will seriously compromise the child's academic learning, we will turn down the application and refund your money. Parents should also exercise thoughtful judgment before choosing to enroll a child who may struggle academically. Once enrollment begins, children are responsible for their behavior and regular academic work, and refunds will not be issued if a child is removed from instrumental lessons for these reasons.
